Rehearsals

When and under what circumstances we will be able to assemble again is a big unknown. Even the commonly referenced parameters for 'social distancing' may not be applicable to a brass ensemble. The British Bands Association is suggesting that maybe up to 5 meter spacing might be more appropriate between individual players. As such, our basement rehearsal space will not be suitable (but the sanctuary or the gymnasium could be available).

One criteria will be dictated by Breslau Mennonite Church, probably guided by their insurer, plus our own insurer. Another criteria will be the individual comfort levels of our fellow musicians and that may be quite broad. This will be an issue that will require increasing attention, particularly in regards to what other groups have adopted and on what basis.

I expect that those civil leaders dealing with choosing the best strategies for; opening up the economy, senior's residences, schools needed, with the idea of etc., will be a long time getting time to wonder about the best protocols for community musical groups etc.
